1st Race. 41: The Republican Plate, Div II - (About) 1200 Metres.Horses rated 00 to 25,5years old and over (10 Runners):

Permission was granted to trainer Mr. Bipin V. Salvi to **withdraw** TRUMP BABY (Saqlain.S) on veterinary grounds as it was found to have sustained two inch long cut injury on left fore knee. He was informed that he must produce a **Fitness Certificate** from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

GLOWING MOONLIGHTS (R.Ravi) was extremely fractious on the way to the starting gates, dropped and injured the rider, who was certified medically unfit to ride. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be **withdrawn** before coming under Starter's Order.

SAFFRON BREEZE (Siddaraju P) did not raise a fluent gallop soon after jumping out of the Starting Gates, for the first 200 Metres. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Yogesh. R was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day on the Race Track.

ARMAMENT (Abhishek Mhatre) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the Start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Ranjeet Shinde was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Jump Out** on a Starting Gate Practice Day.

SEDUCTIVE (H.Rahul) jumped awkwardly outwards and bumped SAFFRON BREEZE (Siddaraju.P) on its outside at the start.

Jockey Afsar Khan, the rider of NIMBLE SPIRIT was reprimanded for travelling wide rounding the final bend for no apparent reason.

Jockey A. Ayaz Khan, the rider of RICH STRIKE was reprimanded for riding an indifferent race.

It was reported after the race that SARO RETURNED (V.R.Jagdeesh) burst its blood vessels (Endoscopy Grade – III). Hence, Trainer Mr. Somashekar K was informed that he must produce a **Fitness Certificate** from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

SUPER SEXY (Vinod Shinde) sustained bleeding cut on left hind below hock joint.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from ch g JUST BLUES.

2nd Race. 42: The Kodlipet Plate (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45,5years old and over (12 Runners):

Trainer Mr. J. Ganesh was fined **Rs.10,000/-** for having entered his charge INEFFABLE to run in the above race, when it was under veterinary treatment.

SARVOTTAM (Rajesh.K) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Mansoor Khan was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Jump Out** on a Starting Gate Practice Day.

D ROMAN REIGNS (K.Sai Kiran) took a fly jump at the Start.

SHEER ELEGANCE (SahFarid Ansari) took a fly jump at the Start.

Jockey Koshi Kumar, the rider of O MANCHALI was fined **Rs.1,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to ZEBULA (A. Ayaz Khan) on his inside passing the 400 Metres.

Jockey Inayat, the rider of AVIOTHIC was fined **Rs.1,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to WALTER (S.Antony Raj) on his inside passing the 700 Metres.

It was observed that IRON KING (A.AshhadAsbar) accidentally brushed the running rails approaching the final 100 Metres.

Jockey A. Ayaz Khan, the rider of ZEBULA was reprimanded for dropping hands before passing the winning post.

IRON KING (A.AshhadAsbar) sustained bruises on both hind back of fetlock.

O MANCHALI (Koshi Kumar) sustained bruises on both hind back of fetlock.

D ROMAN POWER (Afsar Khan) sustained bruises on right hind back of fetlock.

3rd Race. 43: The Republican Plate, Div I - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25,5years old and over (11 Runners):

Permission was granted to trainer Mr. Bipin V. Salvi to withdraw ELEVADO on veterinary grounds as it was found to be lame on left fore and had sustained injury with inflammation on shoulder region. He was informed that he must produce a **Fitness Certificate** from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

RAISE A SOUND (Afsar Khan) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Himanshu was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day on the Race Track.

It was observed that GLORY OF HEAVEN (B.Darshan Anthony) brushed the left side of the starting gates while jumping out.

Jockey Anish Anamo Hangal, the rider of HASTING SUNRISE was reprimanded for not maintaining a straight course thereby cutting across the field sharply before passing the Red Marker Post.

Jockey B.Darshan Anthony, the rider of GLORY OF HEAVEN was reprimanded for travelling wide between 800 Metres to 600 Metres for no apparent reason.

GLORY OF HEAVEN (B.Darshan Anthony) ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr. Yogesh R was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Jockey Koshi Kumar, the rider of ANUSHTUBHA reported that his mount was hanging out after entering in the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Rakesh was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

RAISE A SOUND (Afsar Khan) sustained injury on right hind back of cannon.

Routine sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g LORDS GRACE.

4th Race. 44: The Renowned Plate, Div II - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (12 Runners):

LADYLION (R.Vaibhav) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Gnanashekar A was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **Two Mock Races** on Race Days on the Race Track.

Jockey Antony Raj S, the rider of PHOENOMENON was reprimanded for shifting out and inconveniencing COURT JESTER (Faiz) on his outside passing the 1100 Metres.

Jockey C. Umesh, the rider of SPIRIT OF THE ROSE reported that his mount was repeatedly changing its legs in the straight.

WORLDLY WISE (S.Imran) sustained gum injury.

Routine sample was taken for analysis from the winner b g SAPPHIRE.

5th Race. 45: The Stewards Trophy - (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 80 and above (10 Runners):

SANTORINO (L.Alex Rozario) was extremely fractious and refused to be stalled. Under the circumstances, it was permitted to be **withdrawn** before coming under Starter's Order. In view of its repeated unruly behaviour, Trainer Mr. Dhyan Subbaiah K was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day, on the Race Track.

Jockey S. Kabdhar, the rider of DECACORN was reprimanded for travelling wide from 1200 Metres till about the 600 Metres, for no apparent reason.

Jockey B.Darshan Anthony, the rider of GOLD KITE reported that his saddle shifted forward passing the 1000 Metres. After due examination of the equipment, Trainer Mr. Aditya. K was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for faulty saddling of his charge.

PERFECT BLEND (B.Nikhil) sustained bruises on both hind back of fetlock.

6th Race. 46: The Hiriyur, Plate - (About) 1600 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45 (12 Runners):

Trainer Mr. Mansoor Khan was fined **Rs.10,000/-** for negligence in discharge of his duties as a trainer wherein he presented his charge MISTY WARRIOR (Faiz) in the paddock with a wrong saddle cloth number. Subsequently, the same was corrected before the horse left the Paddock.

Jockey Sah Farid Ansari, the rider of STAR OF LIGHT was fined **Rs.2,000/-** for shifting out and bumping the horses on his outside, viz; SAIGON (S.Mubarak) and REIGN OF TERROR (Jitendra Singh), soon after the start.

Jockey Anil Baandal, the rider of SADA was fined **Rs.5,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to horses on his inside viz., NATURAL QUEEN (Rajesh K), NATURAL LOOK (Ankit Pal), ADMIRAL SHAW (C A Brisson) and ISABELLE (Anish Anamo Hangal) passing the 1500 Metres.

Jockey A. Ashhad Asbar, the rider of KING D reported that his mount was hanging out after entering the straight. Trainer Mr. Zulquarnain H was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey C A Brisson, the rider of ADMIRAL SHAW was reprimanded for the undesirable practice of dropping hands in the final 100 Metres.

Jockey Jitendra Singh, the rider of REIGN OF TERROR was reprimanded for the undesirable practice of dropping hands in the final 100 Metres.

7th Race. 47: The Renowned Plate, Div I - (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65 (12 Runners):

Trainer Mr. Mansoor Khan was fined **Rs.10,000/-** for having entered his charge NATURAL DIAMOND to run in the above race, when it was under veterinary treatment.

SHERSHAAH (B.Darshan Anthony) planted, lost many lengths at the start and ran detached from the field thereafter. In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Dhyan Subbaiah K was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future and that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day on the Race Track.

SILVER QUEST (Vinod Shinde) threw its head up in the air while jumping out of the Starting Gates.

Jockey Bharat Mal, the rider of MARK ONE was fined **Rs.3,000/-** shifting 'in' and tightening the horses on his inside viz; ASIO (Abhishek Mhatre), SILENT ACHIEVER (A.R.Pradeep), SHERPA (Faiz) and MAGICAL BAY (S.Antony Raj) along the rails approaching 1000 Metres.

Jockey Anish Anamo Hangal, the rider of ULTIMATE BLUES was reprimanded for riding an indifferent race.

Jockey S. Antony Raj, the rider of MAGICAL BAY was reprimanded for the undesirable practice of dropping hands in the final 100 Metres.

Jockey Vishal, the rider of RAFFINATO was reprimanded for the undesirable practice of dropping hands in the final 100 Metres.

Jockey Faiz, the rider of SHERPA was reprimanded for the undesirable practice of dropping hands before passing the winning post.

Jockey Abhishek Mhatre, the rider of ASIO was fined **Rs.5,000/-** for the excessive use of whip on his mount during the race **(2nd infringement)**.

ULTIMATE BLUES (Anish AnamoHangal)sustained bruise on left hind back of fetlock.

Permission was granted to trainers M/s. P. Krishna and Ranjeet Shinde to deputize on behalf of trainers M/s. Bobby. M and S.S. Attaollahi respectively, who were unable to attend the races.

1st Race. 41: The Republican Plate – Div. II (About) 1200 Metres:

GLOWING MOONLIGHTS (R Ravi) – Was permitted to be withdrawn before coming under the Starters Order, as the Jockey reported medically unfit on its way to the Starting Gate.

ARMAMENT (Abhishek Mhatre) – Was slowly away and lost few lengths.

2nd Race. 42: The Kodlipet Plate (About) 1400 Metres:

D ROMAN REIGNS (K Sai Kiran) – Took a fly jump.

SARVOTTAM (Rajesh K) – Was slowly away and lost about two lengths.

WORDS WORTH (B Darshan Anthony) – Was extremely fractious at the gates and delayed the start for a considerable time. Advised to give adequate gate practice.

3rd Race. 43: The Republican Plate – Div. I (About) 1200 Metres:

RAISE A SOUND (Afsar Khan) planted and lost many lengths.

GLORY OF HEAVEN (B Darshan Anthony) – Brushed the gates while jumping out.

4th Race. 44: The Renowned Plate – Div. II (About) 1200 Metres:

LADYLION (R Vaibhav) – Planted and lost many lengths.

5th Race. 45: The Stewards Trophy (About) 1400 Metres:

SANTORINO (L Alex Rozario) Was extremely fractious and refused to get stalled. The Starting Stall Certificate is revoked.

6th Race. 46: The Hiriyur Plate (About) 1600 Metres:

LEVEL START

7th Race. 47: The Renowned Plate – Div. I (About) 1200 Metres:

SHERSHAAH (B Darshan Anthony) – Planted and lost many lengths.

ORDER OF THE STEWARDS

Inquiry into the test report dated 12th September, 2025, received from Quantilab, Mauritius, pertaining to the analysis of the liquid sample taken from the Syringes confiscated from pant pockets of Mr. Rajan Paswan, Acting Jamadar working for Mr. Pratap Kamath in his presence, from inside the stables allotted to Mr. Pratap Kamath, which has shown the presence of METHADONE (prohibited substance) in both the samples of the liquid contained in 2 loaded syringes, during the raid of the stable block belonging to Mr. Pratap Kamath between 12.15 p.m. and 12.30 p.m., on 30th July 2025 [Race Day - 10th Day of the Mysore Summer Races 2025] – The Case was referred back by the Board of Appeal to the Stewards as fresh evidence was forthcoming, as per Rule No. 47 (j) of the My.R.C. Ltd., Rules of Racing, i.e., presence of METHADONE (prohibited substance) in both the samples of the liquid contained in 2 loaded syringes;

The Stewards, at their meeting held on Tuesday, 23rd June, 2026, noted the fact that they had passed an Order dated 28th August, 2025 pertaining to Charge Sheet No. 368, dated 15th August, 2025, issued to Mr. Pratap Kamath, wherein they had declared Mr. Pratap Kamath a disqualified person for a period of 7 years, i.e., from **from 29-08-2025 to 28-08-2032 [both days inclusive]**, for contravention of Rule Nos. 202 [i], Rule No. 202 [vi], Rule No. 202 [vii], Rule No. 202 [x] [a] [i], Rule No. 202 [xii], Rule No. 202 [xiii] and Rule No. 202 [xvi] of the Rules of Racing of Mysore Race Club Ltd., read with Medication Rule No. 6, Rule No. 12 [i], Rule No. 13 [a], [b], [c], [d], [f] and [g], Rule No. 17, Rule No. 19 [1], Rule No. 23 [c], Rule No. 24 [1], [a], [b], [c] and Rule No. 24 [2], Rule No. 25, Rule No. 26 [1] [i][a] and 27 [1] [2] [4] [a][b] of the Calendar Notification under the heading **"MEDICATION AND TREATMENT OF HORSES IN TRAINING AND RACING AND ANTI-DOPING CONTROL"** of the Mysore Race Club Ltd. They also noted that Mr. Pratap Kamath had appealed against the Order of the Stewards and the Board of Appeal, in their Order dated 16th September, 2025, had reverted the case back to the Stewards due to the forthcoming of fresh evidence as per Rule No. 47 (j) of the My.R.C. Ltd., Rules of Racing, i.e., presence of METHADONE (prohibited substance) in both the samples of the liquid contained in 2 loaded syringes.

The Stewards considered the report of the Stipendiary Stewards and the Chief Veterinary Officer, pertaining to the detection of **METHADONE [Prohibited Substance]** in the analysis report received from QuantiLAB, Mauritius, and the Laboratory report regarding the liquid samples which were taken from the Syringes confiscated from pant pockets of Acting Jamadar Mr. Rajan Paswan, the employee working for Mr. Pratap Kamath, in his presence, from inside the stables allotted to him, was also considered. The Syringes were confiscated from Mr. Rajan Paswan while he was administering/attempting to administer the above drug to one of the runners for that particular Race day, viz., SEOLFOR BULLET. The horse was owned by Col. Kuldeep Singh Garcha and Mr. P M Nanaiah.

The Stewards conducted an enquiry, and examined the Trainer, Mr. Pratap Kamath M, pertaining to the presence of METHADONE (prohibited substance) in both the samples of

the liquid contained in the 2 loaded syringes confiscated from his acting Jamadar, Mr. Rajan Paswan, during the Stable Raid conducted on 30th July, 2025.

The Stewards also took into account the following;

1. The Order of the Stewards dated 28th August, 2025;
2. The Order of the Board of Appeal dated 16th September, 2025;
3. The Laboratory reports dated 12th September, 2025 received from QuatiLAB, Mauritius mentioning the presence of METHADONE a prohibited substance, in both the "A" Samples;
4. The Police Complaint lodged by the Secretary and CEO, My.R.C. Ltd., dated 18th September, 2025 addressed to the Senior Inspector of Police, Nazarbad Police Station, Mysore;
5. The report submitted by the Stipendiary Stewards and the Chief Veterinary Officer, dated 19th June, 2026;
6. The written submissions dated 22nd June, 2026 made by Mr. Pratap Kamath, which was circulated by him during the course of the Enquiry;
7. The oral submissions made by Mr. Pratap Kamath, before the Stewards, on this day, i.e., 23rd June, 2026;

The Stewards noted that it was mentioned in the Order of the Stewards dated 28th August, 2025 that the solutions from both the loaded Syringes were split into two portions and were called "A" and "B" samples and of these samples, "A" samples were sent to QuantiLAB, Mauritius to ascertain whether there are any Prohibited Substance contained therein. The Stewards also noted that the Laboratory Analysis report dated 12th September, 2025 mentions that the solutions contained METHADONE, a Prohibited Substance.

The Stewards also noted the fact that the positive findings of the analysis report, received from QuantiLAB, Mauritius was made known to Mr. Pratap Kamath, vide the Club's letter dated 17th September, 2025 and was sent to him through Speed Post, acknowledgement due, through email and also through WhatsApp which was received and acknowledged by him.

The Stewards of the Club, after detailed discussions and great deal of deliberations concluded that Mr. Pratap Kamath was guilty of administering/attempting to administer METHADONE, a Prohibited Substance, to his horse, viz., SEOLFOR BULLET, as he was caught red handed by the Stipendiary Stewards in trying to administer the said Drug to the said horse. The said horse viz., SEOLFOR BULLET was a runner on that day, i.e., 10th Day of the Mysore Summer Races 2025 run on 30th July, 2025.

Thus the Stewards, considering the facts before them, decided to stand by their previous Order dated 28th August, 2025 wherein they had concluded that Trainer Mr. Pratap Kamath M was guilty of breach of and of grave and gross misconduct liable for punishment under Rule No. 202 [i], Rule No. 202 [vi], Rule No. 202 [vii], Rule No. 202 [x][a][i], Rule No. 202 [xii], Rule No. 202 [xiii] and Rule No. 202 [xvi] of the Rules of Racing of Mysore Race Club Ltd., read with Medication Rule No. 6, Rule No. 12 [i], Rule No. 13 [a], [b], [c], [d], [f] and [g], Rule No. 17, Rule No. 19 [1], Rule No. 23 [c], Rule No. 24 [1], [a], [b], [c] and Rule No. 24[2], Rule No. 25, Rule No. 26 [1][i][a] and 27 [1][2][4][a][b] of the Calendar Notification under the heading "Medication and Treatment of Horses in Training and Racing and Anti-Doping Control" of the Mysore Race Club Ltd and had consequently decided to declare Trainer Mr. Pratap Kamath M a disqualified person for seven years, from the date of this Order i.e., **from 29-08-2025 to 28-08-2032 [both days inclusive]**, for contravention of Rule Nos. 202 [i], Rule No. 202 [vi], Rule No. 202 [vii], Rule No. 202 [x] [a] [i], Rule No. 202 [xii], Rule No. 202 [xiii] and Rule No. 202 [xvi] of the Rules of Racing of Mysore Race Club Ltd., read with Medication Rule No. 6, Rule No. 12 [i], Rule No. 13 [a], [b], [c], [d], [f] and [g], Rule No. 17, Rule No. 19 [1], Rule No. 23 [c], Rule No. 24 [1], [a], [b], [c] and Rule No. 24

[2], Rule No. 25, Rule No. 26 [1] [i][a] and 27 [1] [2] [4] [a][b] of the Calendar Notification under the heading **"MEDICATION AND TREATMENT OF HORSES IN TRAINING AND RACING AND ANTI-DOPING CONTROL"** of the Mysore Race Club Ltd., pertaining to the confiscation of 2 loaded syringes and 2 needles and 1 used syringe and needle from the pant pockets of Acting Jamadar Mr. Rajan Paswan in his [Mr. Pratap Kamath's] presence during the raid conducted by the Stipendiary Stewards at the stable block belonging to him [Mr. Pratap Kamath], between 12.15 p.m. and 12.30 p.m., on 30th July 2025 [Race Day - 10th Race Day of the Mysore Summer Races 2025].

The Stewards also decided to declare Mr. Pratap Kamath a disqualified Person, for a further period of three years i.e., **from 29-08-2032 to 28-08-2035 (both days inclusive)** for the detection of METHADONE, a Prohibited Substance, in the solution found in the Syringes which was confiscated from the pant pockets of his acting Jamadar, Mr. Rajan Paswan, as denoted in the analysis report received from QuantiLAB, Mauritius. Mr. Pratap Kamath was caught red handed by the Stipendiary Stewards while administering/attempting to administer METHADONE, a Prohibited Substance to his horse, SEOLFOR BULLET which was under his charge at that time and owned by Col. Kuldeep Singh Garcha and Mr. P M Nanaiah, for infringement of Medication Rules as contained in Rule No. 23 (a) (b) and (c) of the Medication Rules of My.R.C. Limited, under the heading, Medication and Treatment of Horses in Training and Racing and Anti-Doping Control, reading as under:

RULE No. 23.

The Trainer shall always be responsible and accountable at all times for:-

- (a)** The management, administration, supervision, security and control of horses and of stable employees under his/her charge;
- (b)** The feeding, feed supplements, treatment, stable routine, management, protection and security of the horses in his/her stable;
- (c)** For ensuring that only Veterinarians approved by the Stewards inject or otherwise treat horses in his/her care;.

Mr. Pratap Kamath was informed of his Right to Appeal.

Rule No. 13 [a], [b], [c], [d], [f] and [g], Rule No. 17, Rule No. 19 [1], Rule No. 23 [c], Rule No. 24 [1], [a], [b], [c] and Rule No. 24 [2], Rule No. 25, Rule No. 26 [1] [i][a] and 27 [1] [2] [4] [a][b] of the Calendar Notification under the heading **"MEDICATION AND TREATMENT OF HORSES IN TRAINING AND RACING AND ANTI-DOPING CONTROL"** of the Mysore Race Club Ltd., for confiscation of 2 loaded syringes and 2 needles and 1 used syringe and needle from his pant pockets in the presence of Mr. Pratap Kamath during the raid conducted by the Stipendiary Stewards at the stable block allotted to Mr. Pratap Kamath, between 12.15 p.m. and 12.30 p.m., on 30th July 2025 [Race Day - 10th Race Day of the Mysore Summer Races 2025]. The Stewards also noted that Mr. Rajan Paswan had appealed against the Order of the Stewards to the Board of Appeal, and since the Appeal was not accompanied by the required deposit as per the Rules of Racing of the Club, the Board, at its meeting held on 16th September, 2025, regretted its inability to consider the Appeal. The Stewards of the Mysore Race Club Limited, at their meeting, held on Tuesday, 23rd June, 2026, considered the report of the Stipendiary Stewards and the Chief Veterinary Officer pertaining to the detection of **CLENBUTEROL (Illicit Substance)** in the urine

sample taken from **ch g DABEET** during TESTING IN TRAINING (Out of Competition Testing) for the month of November, 2025. The sample was taken on 11th November, 2025 and the horse is owned by Mr. Jose Joseph and trained by Mr. Ganesh J.

As per the IFHA guidelines, for "Testing in Training" (Out of Competition Testing), **"Any legitimate use of CLENBUTEROL shall be limited to only those horses that have been documented with a clinical diagnosis by a Veterinarian of airway disease indicating the need for its therapeutic use and with the Veterinary and treatment records available to the Racing Authority on request"**.

In the absence of the above record, it is considered as an Illicit Substance.

The Stewards conducted an enquiry, and examined the Trainer, Mr. Ganesh J, pertaining to the presence of **CLENBUTEROL (Illicit substance)** in the urine sample taken from **ch g DABEET** during TESTING IN TRAINING (Out of Competition Testing) for the month of November, 2025.

The Stewards also took into account the following;

1. The Laboratory Analysis report (Sample A) dated 4th December, 2025, received from Primary Laboratory, QuantiLAB, Mauritius, confirming the presence of CLENBUTEROL;
