EIGHTH DAY, FRIDAY, 27th SEPTEMBER 2024

RACING INCIDENTS

(Race No. 42 - 49)

Weather	: Partly Cloudy
Track Condition	: Good Going
Penetrometer reading	: 3.1 Cms.
Positioning of Railings	: Railings are positioned from 1600 metres upto the Winning Post with an average width of 2 metres from its original position.

1st Race: 42. The Penambur Plate (About) 1600 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25 (8 Runners):

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. Irfan Ghatala to **withdraw** SUNLIT PATH (B R Kumar) on veterinary grounds as it sustained bleeding injury on left hind coronet while travelling from Bangalore Turf Club to Mysore. He was informed that he must produce a Fitness Certificate from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

THE BLISSFULELYSEE (M Naveen) reared up, fell down and hit its head very badly to the ground while rolling inside the paddock and thereafter succumbed to the head injury in the paddock.

Jockey Prabhu Kumar M, the rider of STONE HOUSE was reprimanded for taking an unduly long lead right from the Start till 400 metres of the race.

DOUBLE VISION (Abhishek Mhatre) was impounded for veterinary examination, but no abnormality was reported.

The Stipendiary Stewards questioned Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas for the reversal of form and the resultant improved performance of his charge, SEA DIAMOND (P Sai Kumar), the winner of the above Race, as compared to its previous run in Race No. 17 of the Mysore (Monsoon) Races 2024, run on Third Day, Thursday, 12th September, 2024, when ridden by the same rider, it ran unplaced. The Trainer stated as follows; **a)** This horse has run under his charge four times, all in different distances. Prior to that, under Trainer Mr. Pradeep Annaiah's charge, this horse had won a mile race; **b)** This horse had not shown its true potential when it ran four times under him, including its previous run in Mysore over five and a half furlongs; **c)** Because of this reason, he had tried running this charge in various distances, but to no avail and hence on the advise of his rider, who was also working this filly in the morning, he decided to try it over a mile; **d)** In this race, he had instructed his rider to take a good jump and sit well up with the Pace and to ride out in the Straight. His rider rode accordingly and eventually just about won the Race. Not satisfied with the explanation tendered by Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas, the Stipendiary Stewards decided as follows;

a) To fine Trainer Mr. Kishan Thomas a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** for the reversal of form and the resultant improved performance of his charge, SEA DIAMOND (P Sai Kumar), the winner of the above Race, as compared to its previous run in Race No. 17 of the Mysore (Monsoon) Races 2024, run on Third Day, Thursday, 12th September, 2024, when ridden by the same rider, it ran unplaced;

b) Caution him to be more consistent in the running of his charges in future, failing which he shall be reported to the Stewards for appropriate action.

Routine Sample was taken for analysis from the winner, b f SEA DIAMOND.

2nd Race: 43. The Shimsha Plate (About) 1100 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over confined to Mysore based horses (8 Runners):

Permission was granted to Trainer Mr. Bipin V Salvi to **withdraw** ELEVADO (Arvind Kumar N) on veterinary grounds as it was burst its blood vessels, during morning track work on 26/9/2024. He was informed that he must produce a **Fitness Certificate** from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

MAGIC CIRCLE (A R Pradeep) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start; In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Bipin V Salvi was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Jump Out** on a Starting Gate Practice Day.

Jockey Dhanu Singh Deora, the rider of FURIOUS FUN was fined **Rs.2,000/-** for taking an unduly lead rounding the bend.

Jockey R Shiva Kumar, the rider of VIJAYA BRAVE was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for shifting `in` and causing interference to FACETS OF LIFE (Faiz), on his inside, before passing the Red Marker Post.

3rd Race: 44. The Aunty Pip Plate (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 00 to 25, 5 years old and over confined to Mysore based horses (12 Runners):

Jockey Angad the rider of DEEMED TO FIRE was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for failing to maintain his position rounding the bend for no apparent reason.

Jockey Saqlain S the rider of CITY OF HUSTLE reported that his mount was inclined to run out rounding the bend. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported.

FELICITA (Koshi Kumar) was observed to be galloping erratically after entering the straight. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination, but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Helleal Moses was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Jockey Md. Imran Ashraf the rider of RAAZ was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for the inept handling of his mount in the closing stages of the race.

4th Race: 45. The Ranga Family Trophy – Div. I (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45. No whip (15 Runners):

As Jockey M Naveen, the declared rider of THE REPUBLIC POWER, was certified medically unfit to ride, permission was granted to Trainer Mr. Ganesh J to substitute Jockey S Imran to ride THE REPUBLIC POWER in place of the declared rider.

GOLDEN SPARSH (Abhishek Mhatre) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start; In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Bipin V Salvi was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Jump Out** on a Starting Gate Practice Day.

QUEEN OF COMEBAKS (R Shiva Kumar) was slowly away and lost few lengths at the start; In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Rakesh was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Jump Out** on a Starting Gate Practice Day.

Jockey V R Jagdeesh the rider of INEFFABLE was fined **Rs.2,000/-** for taking an unduly long lead right from the start till rounding the final bend.

INEFFABLE (V R Jagdeesh) accidentally brushed the railing approaching the 1000 Metres.

Jockey P Kiran Rai the rider of GILDED BUTTERFLY was reprimanded for not maintaining a proper course, rounding the bend.

Jockey Abhishek Mahtre, the rider of GOLDEN SPARSH, reported that his saddle shifted back, rounding the final bend, and as such, he could not offer any assistance to his mount thereafter; After due examination of the equipment, Trainer Mr. M Bipin V Salvi was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for faulty saddling.

5th Race: 46. The M B Appaya Memorial Trophy (About) 1400 metres. Horses rated 60 and above (9 Runners) :

D GOLD STAR (Brahmmesh S) accidentally brushed the Railings, approaching the 1200 Metres.

PRINCE CORPORATE (Rajesh K) accidentally brushed the Railings, approaching the 1100 Metres.

Jockey Hemant Chandragiri, the rider of PEYO, was reprimanded for travelling wide, rounding the bend and after entering the Straight.

Jockey M Rajesh Kumar, the rider of KINGOFTHEJUNGLE, was reprimanded for shifting in and inconveniencing ARALINA (Saqlain S), on his inside, approaching the 400 Metres.

At the behest of the Stipendiary Stewards, a Stewards enquiry was held immediately after the Race to look into the start of the race in particular. Jockey Suraj Narredu, the rider of STELLANTIS, drawn Nine, reported after the Race that, "just as the start was to be effected, his mount suddenly got restless and suddenly hit the front of the stall and as a result, my stall opened forcefully, a fraction of a second before the actual start being affected by the Starter" and as such, he thought that it was a false start. The Stewards viewed the Start of the race and perused the CCTV replays of all the available angles. They also examined the Starters, Mr. Kiran M and Mr. Shanmukha Swamy K S and recorded their statements. After due discussions and after detailed discussions, the Stewards concluded that due to STELLANTIS banging the front of its stall, its stall opened a fraction of a second earlier than the other Stalls, but this incident did not create an undue advantage to any rider in the above Race. Thus, the Stewards decided a fair start was given in the above Race and hence decided not to alter the Judges Placings of the above Race.

6th Race: 47. The Maharaja's Cup 2024 (Grade - II) (About) 1600 Metres. For Indian horses 4 years old and over (8 Runners):

Jockey P Sai Kumar the rider of IRON CLAD reported that his mount ducked in at the Start.

SPECTACULAR (V R Jagdeesh) sustained gum injury and also injury on left fore coronet.

Compulsory Sample was taken for analysis from the following first three placed horses:

7th Race: 48. The Ranga Family Trophy - Div. II (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45. No Whip (15 Runners):

THE WELCOME (S Imran) planted and lost many lengths at the start; In view of its behaviour, Trainer Mr. Ganesh J was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improved to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day on the race track.

Jockey Prabhu Kumar M the rider of INFINITEPOSSIBILITY was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for shifting `in' and causing interference to ALLURING BEAUTY (Abhishek Mhatre) on his inside between the 1300 Metres and the 1200 Metres and as such the latter stumbled.

SHADOW'S AIM (M Rajesh Kumar) jumped awkwardly `outwards' at the start.

SHADOW'S AIM (M Rajesh Kumar) accidentally brushed the railing between the 1100 Metres and the 1000 Metres of the race.

Jockey Koshi Kumar the rider of D LORD was reprimanded for travelling wide throughout the race.

Jockey Shreyas Singh the rider of LG'S SCRIPT reported that his mount was running green and thereafter, ran detached from the field. Trainer Mr.Lokanath V was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

8th Race: 49. The Son of the Light Plate (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over confined to Mysore based horses (8 Runners):

It was observed that COORG GENERAL (Dhanu Singh Deora) and SERGEANT RECKLESS (Fiaz) bumped into each other, at the Start.

The Stipendiary Stewards questioned Jockey Fiaz, the rider of SERJEANT RECKLESS, for his riding, on his mount, in the above Race. After due enquiry, not being satisfied with the explanation tendered by Jockey Fiaz, the Stipendiary Stewards decided as follows;

a) To fine Jockey Fiaz **Rs.3,000/-** for not making sufficient effort to improve position of his mount and keep in touch with the front runners, thereby allowing them to take an advantageous lead, which eventually cost him dearly. He was cautioned that a similar manner of riding of his mounts in future shall entail him being reported to the Stewards for appropriate action;

b) Note the explanations of Trainer Mr. C D Monnappa and caution him to be more consistent in the manner of running of his charges in future.

SERGEANT RECKLESS (Faiz) sustained small injuries inside left hock.

Permission was granted to Trainers M/s Rakesh, M Rajendra Singh and Rajesh Narredu to deputise on behalf of Trainers M/s Sulaiman S Attaollahi, S Dominic and S Narredu respectively, who could not attend the day's races
